DESCRIPTION:

CALCIUM NEUTRALIZER DETERGENT SOLUTION is a neutralizer detergent very effective to clean floors soiled by ice melt products during winter. CALCIUM NEUTRALIZER DETERGENT SOLUTION provides the end user with a very pleasant cherry smell, contrarily to the strong odors of the acid products. Moreover, it can be used as a cleaner for stone floors and as a neutralizer after stripping.

DIRECTIONS:

CALCIUM NEUTRALIZER DETERGENT SOLUTION is used with an auto-scrubber or manually with a mop. TO CLEAN FLOORS DURING THE WINTER PERIOD: Use 10 to 30 ml of CALCIUM NEUTRALIZER DETERGENT SOLUTION per litre (1 1/2 to 5 oz per gallon) of water. TO NEUTRALIZE FLOORS: To neutralize a surface after stripping, use 10 ml of CALCIUM NEUTRALIZER DETERGENT SOLUTION per litre (1 1/2 oz per gallon). FOR REGULAR MAINTENANCE OF GRANITE AND LIMESTONE FLOORS OR CERAMIC TILES: Use 10 to 30 ml of CALCIUM NEUTRALIZER DETERGENT SOLUTION per litre (1 1/2 to 5 oz per gallon) of water.

CAUTION:

CAUSES BURNS DANGEROUS FUMES FORM WHEN MIXED WITH OTHER PRODUCTS - Do not mix with Alkali. Do not swallow. Do not get in eyes. Do not get on skin or clothing. Do not breathe fumes.
